HECM Counseling

Schuylkill Community Action is proud to announce the availability of **Home Equity Conversion Mortgage** (**HECM) Counseling**, provided by our HUD-certified housing counselors.

A HECM is a reverse mortgage insured by the FHA that allows homeowners 62 and older to access their home equity while continuing to live in their home.

Benefits include:

- No monthly mortgage payments
- Flexible use of funds (e.g., medical expenses, home repairs, daily needs)
- Ability to stay in your home long-term

To be eligible, homeowners must meet FHA property standards and have the ability to pay property taxes, insurance, and related costs. For more information or to schedule counseling, call us at **(570) 622-1995.**

Asthma/COPD Remediation

We are excited to introduce our **Asthma/COPD Remediation Home Repair Program** – a new healthfocused initiative addressing environmental triggers
inside the home.

This program is designed to make vital home repairs that can help improve living conditions for individuals with respiratory illnesses such as asthma or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD).

Examples of eligible repairs include:

- Mold remediation
- Ventilation improvements
- Elimination of moisture or pest intrusion

Participants also receive a free cleaning supply kit, which may include a HEPA vacuum, mop set, mattress/pillow covers, all-purpose cleaner, etc.
